**ORDER GRANTING RECEIVER’S MOTION FOR ORDER AUTHORIZING
RECEIVER TO TERMINATE GUARDIAN SERVICES, LLC INDIVIDUAL
RETIREMENT ACCOUNTS**

Bradley W. Skolnik, Court-appointed Receiver (the “Receiver”), having filed his “Motion for Order Authorizing Receiver to Terminate Guardian Services, LLC Individual Retirement Accounts” (the “Guardian IRA Motion”) which motion is on file with the Court and a part of the Court’s record in this cause, and the Court having examined same and being duly advised, now finds that said motion should be GRANTED.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Receiver is authorized to terminate the approximately seven hundred (700) Individual Retirement Accounts for which Guardian Services, LLC (“Guardian”) serves as custodian (the “Guardian IRAs”) upon sixty (60) days notice to the owners and beneficiaries of the Guardian IRAs, as more fully set forth herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Receiver shall mail or cause to be mailed the "Guardian IRA Information Packet," as defined in the Guardian IRA Motion, to all owners and beneficiaries of the Guardian IRAs as determined by Guardian's records within thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Receiver is authorized to transfer or distribute the Guardian IRAs to their respective owners and beneficiaries based upon their election following receipt of the Guardian IRA Information Packet.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that if no election is received from a Guardian IRA owner or beneficiary within sixty (60) days of the date the Guardian IRA Information Packet was mailed by the Receiver, the Receiver is authorized to distribute the respective Guardian IRA directly to the owner or beneficiary as determined by Guardian's records.
