**ORDER GRANTING RECEIVER'S MOTION TO AUTHORIZE THIRD PARTIAL  
DISTRIBUTIONS TO HOLDERS OF "CATEGORY B" AND "OTHER" BONDS,  
INVESTORS IN BOND FUNDS AND APPROVED TRADE CREDITORS**


Bradley W. Skolnik, Court-appointed Receiver (the "Receiver"), having filed his "Motion to Authorize Third Partial Distributions to Holders of 'Category B' and 'Other' Bonds, Investors in Bond Funds and Approved Trade Creditors," which motion is on file with the Court and a part of the Court's record in this cause, and the Court having examined same and being duly advised, now finds that said motion should be GRANTED.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Receiver is authorized to use \$10,000,000 of pooled funds from the Receivership Estate to make partial distributions to holders of "Category B" and "Other" Bonds and Investors in Bond Funds, as those terms are defined by the August 28, 2007 Approved Alternative Alanar Receivership Plan (Docket No. 321), and to those "Trade Creditors" whose "Trade Creditor Claims" have been

approved by the Receiver, as those terms are defined by the June 12, 2009 Trade Creditor Claims Procedure (Docket No. 724).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that distributions will not be made where the amount distributed will be less than \$10, but the Receiver shall hold such amounts until a subsequent distribution where the aggregate amount to be distributed is \$10 or more.
