**AGREED ORDER TO ADD REEVES FAMILY LIMITED
PARTNERSHIP TO RECEIVERSHIP**

Plaintiff, United States Securities and Exchange Commission (“Commission”), Receiver, Bradley W. Skolnik, and Defendant, Vaughn A. Reeves, Sr. (“Vaughn Reeves”) have submitted an Agreed Motion to Add the Reeves Family Limited Partnership (“RFLP”) to the Receivership in this civil action.

And the Court, having considered the Motion and being duly advised, now finds that said Motion should be GRANTED.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the RFLP and all its assets are property of the Receivership, and the Receiver shall have, with respect to the RFLP, the powers and duties enumerated in Paragraph III of the Court’s Amended Order Granting Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission’s Motion to Convert Monitorship to Receivership, entered May 1, 2006.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the gross proceeds realized by the sale of any RFLP assets shall be applied as a payment towards Vaughn Reeves' total disgorgement obligation, including prejudgment interest, as well as any civil penalties that are ordered against him.
